Mr. Arthur has had an extensive career in both the public and private sector spanning over 20 years, with specialisation in Project Development, Development Finance, Banking and Investment Management. Within the public sector space he has held positions as Economic Analyst, Debt Analyst, Project Manager and Budget Management Specialist for both local and international organisations. He has also undertaken Public Expenditure Reviews (PER) consultancy for the UNDP and UNICEF.
